**We would like to ask users of Ringwould Village Green to be mindful of residents and their property surrounding it, so as not to cause distress.**

#### **Users, Sports people and Parents:**

- Respect residents right to a peaceful and safe environment.
- The large recreation ground off Queens Rise is more suitable for Ball games. If you're having a match head there.
- If you do play ball on the Green, please use a soft ball to prevent damage to your neighbours' fences, gardens and cars - ask before getting back play equipment.
- Do not leave sports equipment on the village Green when not using it.
- Keep the noise down and don't use abusive language.
- Compromise, speak to your neighbours to sort out any issues.

#### **Residents, Spectators and Passers-by:**

- Playing ball games is not anti-social behaviour or illegal in an open space.
- Respect people's right to play in their own neighbourhood.
- Expect, within reason, noise of children playing after school, at weekends and in the evening.
- Compromise, speak to your neighbours to sort out any issues.
- Open spaces are for the use of everyone.
