Public Rights of Way, other paths and pavements

The Parish Council is aware that trees are still required to be cleared in a few places. However, due to the difficulty in getting Tree Surgeons – they have been inundated with requests of work – this may take longer than even the PC would like.

It is hoped that moving forward, the trees on the Dover/Deal Road can be inspected in the coming weeks, to ensure their safety. This is will be on the agenda for the April meeting and any subsequent meeting if required. To agree as a way for ward depending on price.

Allotments

Most of the clearance work involving the large overgrown trees has now been carried out, although more work still needs to be done. I would like to remind all allotment holders that the allotment is for growing vegetables to feed your family. You are allowed to give away any that are over and above your needs, for your own consumption, maybe you could do a swap. We hope to get a new noticeboard put up so that information can be passed to plot holders in an quicker and easier manner, so watch this space.

The allotment plots have been inspected and it has been noted that some are not being kept cultivated to the required amount.
